

Liturgy Day: The Roman Missal

Keynote presentation: Rev. Paul de Ladurantaye, director of the Office of Sacred Worship of the Diocese of Arlington, will share his unique and probing insights into the patristic thought and scriptural riches revealed by the new translation of the Missal, putting us in closer touch with the Eucharistic theology of the council Fathers whose vision of reformed liturgy is their legacy to us today.

Two practical breakouts will be offered, designed to allow participants to switch at the break or remain in the same presentation:

Breakout A - *Teaching the Missal Chants* – detailed strategies for teaching assemblies, priests and deacons

Part 1: *The Doxology of the Eucharistic Prayer, Basic Dialogues and the Preface*. Part 2: *The Eucharistic Prayer/Aclamations, Collects, Solemn Blessing & Dismissal*

Breakout B - *Several new Mass settings: Gloria, Sanctus and Memorial Acclamations from Mass of Wisdom* (Steven Janco),
Mass of Renewal (William Gokelman & David Kauffman),
Mass of the Holy Trinity (Ken Canedo) , and
Psallite Mass (Collegeville Composers Group).

Also the *Gloria* from *Mass for a New World* (David Haas),
Holy Name of Jesus Gloria (Norah Duncan, IV) and
the *Sanctus* from *Mass in Honor of St. Benedict* (Robert LeBlanc).

The music will be presented by an ensemble of vocalists with simple instrumentation, and will incorporate both unison and choral singing and a discussion of its important features and possibilities for use in worship. Even if you have chosen a new setting, you will need a second one someday!
